



## Shou Sugi Ban

Shou Sugi Ban, also known as Yakisugi, is a traditional Japanese technique of wood burning, which was born as a result of the belief in increased durability and protection against fungi and pests of heavily burned boards. An additional aspect that has influenced its popularity and use till this day not only in Japan are the extremely attractive visual effects that are obtained when burning wood with fire. What's more, the wood burnt with the Shou Sugi Ban technique is famous for the fact that – thanks to this treatment – it maintains its durability for about 50-60 years, which is an additional argument in favor of its growing popularity.
